You need to add your own voice when you are writing.

Have you made your writing your own?

Conventions/Sentence Fluency

Your sentences should have correct grammar, spelling, and word usage and use a variety of sentence types, lengths, and patterns.

- Did you edit your work to correct any mistakes?
- Are your sentences different lengths?

Presentation

Your writing should be ready to share with others.

- Did you use your best handwriting?
- Is it typed in an easy-to-read format and font?
